## CLEANING AND HYGIENE POLICY

Electric City Soccer is fully committed to safeguarding the health and safety of all participants, volunteers and staff. For this reason, effective immediately, all Electric City staff and volunteers, regardless of position or authority, must comply with the following facility cleaning and hygiene policy:

Electric City is responsible for explaining to all staff and volunteers the cleaning protocols and frequency of all common areas and equipment.

Electric City is responsible for explaining to all staff and volunteers the proper use of cleaning supplies and safety concerns of products used.

Electric City is responsible for explaining to all staff and volunteers how to clean and disinfect after persons suspected/confirmed to have COVID-19 have been in the facility.

Electric City is responsible for providing a cleaning schedule to all staff and volunteers.

### Electric City Staff must ensure:

- All staff and volunteers understand facility cleaning and hygiene procedures;
- Staff, volunteers and participants do not share equipment, when possible. High-touch surfaces and equipment are disinfected between users;
- Equipment is disinfected after use, as outlined in Electric City's Return to Play Health Information and Guidelines.

### Electric City Staff and volunteers are responsible for:

- Replenishing or letting the person-in-charge know when cleaning supplies are low;
- Performing cleaning as scheduled;
- Using proper disinfecting supplies.
