PARENTS:

ALL Parents...

- Remember children are involved in organized sports for their enjoyment, not yours. Do not force an unwilling child to participate.
- Attempt to minimize the pressure of competition and place the emotional and physical well being of players ahead of a desire to win.
- Teach your player that hard work and an honest effort are often more important than a victory. Help your player work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship – even in defeat your child will be a winner.
- Be a positive role model whenever you are around players. Set a good example – do not yell at, ridicule, or criticize your child or any other player. Instead applaud good plays by your team and by those of the opposing team.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from youth sporting activities.
- Show respect to all coaches, referees, and tournament officials. Electric City Soccer supports a zero tolerance policy as to questioning and harassment of referees. Leave conflict resolution to the field marshals or tournament officials.
- Be respectful toward coaches, referees, your child, other parents and their children.
- Alert coaches of any players' health conditions.
- **Refrain from coaching and refereeing “from the sidelines”.**
- Make every effort to drop off and pick up players at designated practice and game times.
- Parents will discuss constructive concerns regarding coach, players or Club policy **with the coach first**, Director of Coaching, and finally, through the Club's Executive Director.

All participants of ECSC shall abide by the Club's Code of Conduct at all times. Inappropriate behavior that is determined to violate this Code of Conduct shall result in Disciplinary Action by the ECSC Board of Directors, up to and including, without limitation, expulsion from the game/field, and expulsion from the ECSC.
